GALLEY RECIPIES

Rock Hall "Caviar"

2 or more cans of black beans (DRAINED)
1 can black eyed peas
1 can shoepeg corn
1 can diced tomatoes
2 tsps cumin
2 chopped green onions (scallions)
1/4 diced onion
1/3 diced red pepper

Toss with Italian dressing right before serving and serve with "Scoops" chips
